INTRODUCTION

FAREAST INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY is a Government approved University which provides job-oriented education. Moreover, as a higher seat of learning, **FAREAST INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY** tries to promote and inculcate ethical values and social norms. With this end in view it is proposed to introduce Islamic Studies under the Faculty of Liberal Arts and Social Science of **FIU**.

OBJECTIVE

The objective of the BA Honors in Islamic Studies is to present Islam as a code of life based on the revealed knowledge of the Qur'an and the Sunnah. So the curriculum is

designed to enable students to have a comprehensive view on development of human life according to the teaching and practical guidance of the Qur'an and the Sunnah.

Accordingly a new discussion of Islamic Economics and Administration has also been emphasized.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENT

Course Description:

The courses offered for B.A (Hons) students are grouped into (1) Core courses (compulsory for all) (2) General education courses (Compulsory for all) (3) Concentration (elective) courses with alternatives.

Break-up of the Credit Hours:

i)	Total credit hours	: 132

Credit:

The credits to be taken in each semester minimum 09 and maximum 15. This may be relaxed only with special permission of the appropriate authority.

Course Tenure:

There will be 3 semesters in each year and students of BA (Honours) will complete 132 credits in 12 semesters of within the duration of 4 years.

Admission Requirement:

1. For B.A (Honours) Program

- 1. Minimum two second divisions or one first division and one-third division or 4 CGPA in S.S.C/ Dakhil and H.S.C/Alim or equivalent examinations.
- 2. Candidate will be selected for admission on the basis of a written test and a viva voce.
- 3. Students having break of study may apply.
- 4. Obtaining qualifying marks at the admission test.
